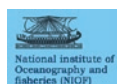
The Young Water Ambassadors will present their Mediterranean Union

5th World Water Forum - Istanbul, Turkey - 17, 20 and 21 March 2009

The Mediterranean Union for Young Water Ambassadors (UMJAE) was created at the initiative of the president of the Water Embassy association, Mrs Jeannette Prétot, Lebanese Arab and French European, who had the desire of regaining a common culture between the Northern and Southern countries of the Mediterranean: "Because it is time to learn how to share our knowledge, our sensibilities, our techniques, without ranking them or judging them : the field decides, and the field is made out of human beings that one must know how to listen to".

The Water Embassy, a non-profit making association under French Law, was created in 2006 after observing that in the world there is an unequal access to water. The association's goal is to work on water related problems in developing countries. Its action revolves around a number of themes: awareness raising, training,

information, accomplishment. With the support of the Seine Normandy Water Agency, the association organises, among other actions, Water Classes for students of all levels, as well as de-centralised cooperation projects based on the Oudin / Santini Act (French solidarity law) which allows that 1% of each water bill to be invested in the construction of infrastructures in developing countries.



1st meeting of the Mediterranean Union for Young Water Ambassadors

During a workshop, the Young Ambassadors will share the draft decentralised cooperation projects that they have developed in their country during the Mediterranean Water Classes. They will then work together with their official representative at building up actual suggestions for decentralised cooperation projects. Thus, in front of a panel of experts, each Water Class Ambassador from a participating developing country will present a field action aimed at fighting against the water-related problems found in her/his country (sanitation, irrigation, access to drinking water) and that has a link with the clean-up of the Mediterranean. The Water Classes Ambassadors from the participating developed countries will have to find European local authorities that are willing to participate in the realisation of the field projects through twinning with the local authorities of the developing countries involved in the Mediterranean Union for Young Water Ambassadors Project.
